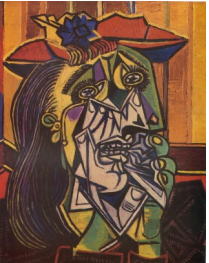
Facts about the artist:

- Nurses thought Picasso had died when he was born, luckily his uncles saved him.
- He has 23 words in his name.
- His father taught him how to paint and aged 9 Picasso completed his first painting which was called Le picador, which was a man riding a horse in a bullfight.
- His first 'real' painting was First Communion, which was a portrait of his father, mother, and younger sister in church. Picasso was 15 when he finished it.
- He grew up in Barcelona, Spain but later moved to Paris, France at a time when there were lots of artists living and working together there.
- In 1909, Picasso and French artist Georges Braque began an art movement known as cubism.

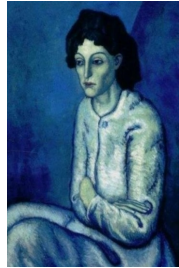
The weeping woman



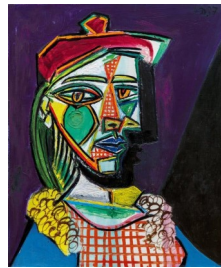
Seated woman resting on elbows

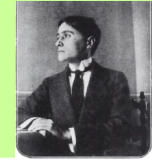
