

## Facts about the artist:

- Joan Miró was a Spanish Catalan painter, born in Barcelona in 1893.
- As well as painting, he enjoyed sculpting and printmaking.
- Before he became an artist, he attended business school and worked as a clerk. He painted in different styles throughout his life.
- From 1920, Miró painted in a Magical Realist style. He painted carefully, and made things look quite realistic. Some parts of his paintings seem slightly strange or unusual. The paintings feel almost real, but as if something is not quite right. This creates a feeling that the paintings are magical, or like a dream.
- Later, he became more influenced by Picasso and his paintings became more surreal and unusual.






Catalan Landscape
