- Born in Bradford in 1937, Hockney was one of the big artists involved in the pop art movement in the 1960s.
- Pop art was a style of art that was bright, full of colour. It was made by lots of young artists who felt that the art they saw in galleries was a little bit boring.
- Hockney paints people, landscapes and objects.
- He is particularly famous for his paintings of his swimming pool.
