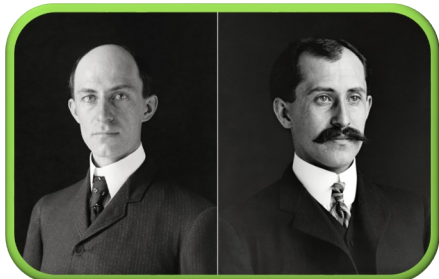


Wright Brothers



Amelia Earhart



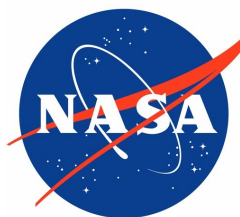
- Invented and built the first airplane.

- American mathematician who worked for NASA.
- In 1962, she worked out how to land on the moon.

- American astronaut.
- In 1969, Neil flew to the moon in Apollo 11.

- In 2016, he was the first British astronaut to walk in space.
- He stayed on the International Space Station for 186 days.
