

Key Stage 2 Assessment Results 2019 and 2023

Schools are required to publish KS2 data on their websites - showing their most recent KS2 results. The following document provides statistical information comparing our pupils' attainment and achievement compared to National counterparts.

As a result of the Covid-19 pandemic, schools were instructed to close on Friday 20th March 2020 to pupils other than those in vulnerable groups or whose parents are key workers. The government then took the decision to cancel the Key Stage 2 SATs and therefore no external data is available for the 2020 and 2021 cohorts. The outcomes of SATs and assessments in 2022 are for internal purposes only and so no data will be published from 2022.
