

These survey results are based on 150 respondents.


What is your child's gender?




What year is your child in?




My child is happy at school.




My child feels safe at school.




The school makes sure that pupils behave well.




The school has high expectations for my child.




My child does well at school.




The school keeps me informed of my child's progress.




There is a good range of subjects available to my child at school.




My child has good opportunities to take part in clubs and activities at school. 150 responses




My child has been bullied and the school dealt with it quickly and effectively. 150 responses



My child has special educational needs and the school gives them the required support to succeed.




When I raise a concern with the school they deal with it promptly and effectively. 150 responses

From September we have been up and running with our extra-curricular provision. We currently have 18 extra-curricular clubs running per week ranging from art club to judo to choir. We will continue to look for further clubs that we can offer as well as consult with the pupils about what type of clubs they would like so that we can offer the best possible opportunities.
