WALLASEY ROTARY SHOEBOX APPEAL

This year the school is supporting the **Rotary Shoe Box Scheme**. The scheme provides gifts for children and families in Eastern Europe, who live in very poor circumstances.

There are three different types of shoe box that you can fill:

- Toys for the younger children
- Teenage items for boys and girls up to 18 years old
- Household items for families, (this can also be used for older folk who we visit)

You do not need to decide which type until you get your box and then you indicate on the lid which type you are filling.

The Wallasey Rotary Club provides shoe boxes in which to place your gifts. These boxes are made especially strong to protect the contents during their long journey.

Please use only these boxes and not ordinary shoeboxes.

The boxes can be decorated with felt tips or crayons as long as the top surface, indicating who the box is for, is visible. There is also space to add your name, as the person making the gift.

Boxes will be collected from school and taken to a central Rotary Warehouse before being delivered before Christmas to one of the countries in need. In the past these countries have included: Belarus, Ukraine, Romania, Bulgaria and Albania.

To complete the gift, a £2 donation is requested to help pay towards transport etc cost to Eastern Europe.

If you would like to fill one of these shoe boxes please pay the £2.00 donation as soon as possible online, it appears as a shop item in School Money. The box will then be issued to you and we ask that you return it to school by **Friday 9th November 2018**
