FLORAL PAVILION THEATRE VISIT

Following our previous very successful whole school visits to both the Liverpool Empire and Floral Pavilion Theatres, I am delighted to inform you that our annual theatre visit has been arranged to take all the children to see Snow White and the Seven Dwarves at the Floral Pavilion on Tuesday 10th December 2019.

We will leave school shortly after morning registration on the 10th December for the 10.00am performance and return to school for a slightly later lunchtime.

This is a wonderful opportunity for the children to experience live theatre and will be a very exciting and memorable occasion for them.

We have already purchased 520 tickets to ensure the children, staff and parent helpers are sitting together in blocks of seats. If you wish to be a helper on this visit, please indicate on the form below. Due to changes in safeguarding arrangements for children, which came into force September 2012, there is no longer a requirement for parents to have DBS clearance on this school trip.

The PTA has very generously agreed to subsidise the transport costs of all the coaches to and from the theatre in order to keep the costs down to a minimum.

The cost of this visit is £10.00 per pupil/adult but as you will be aware this is a voluntary contribution. However, in order that we can continue providing these additional experiences to enhance the curriculum for the children, I would be very grateful if you could cover the cost of your child(ren) taking part.
