EDUCATIONAL VISIT FOR GEOGRAPHY TOPIC, MERSEY FERRY TRIP

On Monday 11th March, Year 4 will be going on the River Mersey as part of their geography topic. The children will be getting the ferry across to Liverpool and then back again to the Wirral, looking at the buildings on either side. We shall also be visiting the Museum of Liverpool.

Children must wear school uniform and bring a waterproof coat. We will leave school at approximately 9.30 a.m. and be back in school by the end of the school day. Children will need a packed lunch in a throw away bag and a water bottle (no glass bottles, please).

The cost for each pupil will be **£8.00** which covers the cost of the coach to Woodside Ferry and the ferry trip itself. **Please pay online via www.schoolmoney.co.uk, where this visit can be found as a payment option in your child's account.** As you are aware we can only ask for a voluntary contribution towards the cost of the visit. However, if the costs are not met the visit will not be able to go ahead. Money is, therefore, required by 8th March.

Please note that this visit is covered by the Parental Consent for school trips and other off site activities form that you have completed for your child. Please notify school immediately if there are any changes to your contact/emergency details or medical information or if you do not wish your child to participate in any of the stated activities.
